TEST SITE EQUIPMENT LIST

FOR TEST SITES: To be approved, a testing site must have all the materials listed for Test Sites. Please refer to the following list for equipment and supplies the test site must have.

FOR TASE RN TEST OBSERVERS: Your role is crucial. To remain certified and active, you must check test sites before each test event. Your task is to ensure that the test site equipment listed herein is available and in good working order. If not, you will report missing or inoperable test site equipment by listing it under the test irregularities in the test event before submitting your test event observations for scoring.

EQUIPMENT/SUPPLIES REQUIRED BY THE TEST SITE

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At least three Internet-connected computers, laptops, or tablets in the Knowledge Test room • Internet-connected computer, laptop, or tablet in the Skill Test room • Hand washing sink with warm running water, soap, and paper towels (<i>paper towel dispenser should be automatic advancing or pull-out type, not one that a bar or lever has to be touched to advance paper towels; must have manual hand faucets, no automatic faucets or foot pedals – sink cannot be used for dirty water disposal</i>). The sink must be no further than a 20-second walk from the skills demonstration area. • Long-term care bed(s) with working bed brakes and bed controls (<i>beds with brakes that are locked when the bed is raised (legs stay down) and beds that sound an alarm when the brakes are not locked are not acceptable. Brakes have to be manually engaged.</i>) • Manikin (<i>full body, anatomically correct – with peri area for female and male</i>) • Working privacy curtain(s) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Foldable/portable screens/curtains are not allowed.</i> • Bedside stand • Overbed table • Wastebasket(s) • Gait belts/transfer belts • Food tray and disposable spoons • Sample food items (single-serve size containers of applesauce, pudding, etc.) • Mandatory Diet card (<i>available on Headmaster's Oregon webpage</i>), disposable spoons, napkins, and bendable straws • 1 clear 240ml glass and 1 clear 120ml glass for the Feeding Task <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Provided in RN testing kit from Headmaster.</i> • Teaching – (binaural) stethoscope and two sizes of blood pressure cuffs • Pulse oximeter (<i>finger type or vital signs monitor</i>) • Touchless infrared thermometer • Disposable adult briefs with small plastic garbage bags • Disposable wipes for hand hygiene in the Feeding Task • Disposable gloves in assorted sizes • Isolation gowns (<i>can be reusable cloth or disposable gowns; tie closure, Velcro closure, or slip-over-the-head gowns are allowed</i>) • Non-skid footwear for actor (<i>easy to put on; slipper socks are not allowed</i>) • Oversized button-up shirt, sweat pants/shorts, socks that will easily fit over the actor's clothing • Pens/pencils for recordings | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Laundry receptacle(s) (hamper) • Hand sanitizer(s) • Toilet or commode (if a toilet is not available in the skills lab) • Wall clocks – in the knowledge test room and skills lab <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Skills lab clock must have a second hand and be easily visible</i> • Call light or signaling device <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Doesn't have to be a working signaling device.</i> • Wheelchair with working brakes and removable footrests <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Footrests are removed for testing.</i> • Walker • Chair(s) • Bedpans (one standard and one fracture) • Tissue/toilet paper • Linens including clean washcloths, towels, bath blankets, barriers (such as waterproof (incontinence) pads, chux, etc.), residents' gowns (tie type, no snaps), pillows (4) • Catheter with tubing • Urinary drainage bag with tubing • Washbasins • Emesis basins • Output measurement container/graduate • Scratch paper • Official data recording forms <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Available on Headmaster's Oregon webpage.</i> • Small clipboard to place the recording form on • Actor's toothbrush, toothpaste, and disposable cups • Soap -<i>PERI-WASH AND NO RINSE SOAPS ARE NOT ALLOWED</i> • Alcohol wipes/pads or antiseptic wipes • Basic watch with a second hand or travel clock with a second hand • AUDIO KNOWLEDGE EXAM ADMINISTRATION: Disposable wired earbuds or headphones that can plug into the computer speaker jack <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Bluetooth-connected devices are not allowed.</i> • Pre-measured 'urine' fluid amounts in unmarked containers (<i>hint: use yellow food coloring in water</i>) • Two audible countdown timers (one for a 15-minute-left warning and one for 35-minute time up) or use the countdown timer on the TMU© Observer screen • Optional: A syringe to easily fill the drainage bag with pre-measured fake 'urine' |
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ROOM REQUIREMENTS

- The knowledge and skill test areas must be completely enclosed
 - *With doors at all entrances and floor-to-ceiling walls to minimize noise and distractions.*
- Distraction- and Interruption-free Skills Lab – with all equipment and supplies listed available and in good working order.
 - *Any signage (posters) or displays that may cue candidates must be covered or removed for test days.*
 - *If the skills lab and/or knowledge test room has any interior windows (i.e., on the door), they would need to be covered (blinds/etc.) during testing.*
- Distraction- and interruption-free Knowledge Test Room
 - *Not needed with remotely proctored knowledge testing.*
- Holding or Waiting Area – where candidates may wait to take the exam

For test security reasons, active cameras or video devices are prohibited in the skills lab or knowledge test room!
